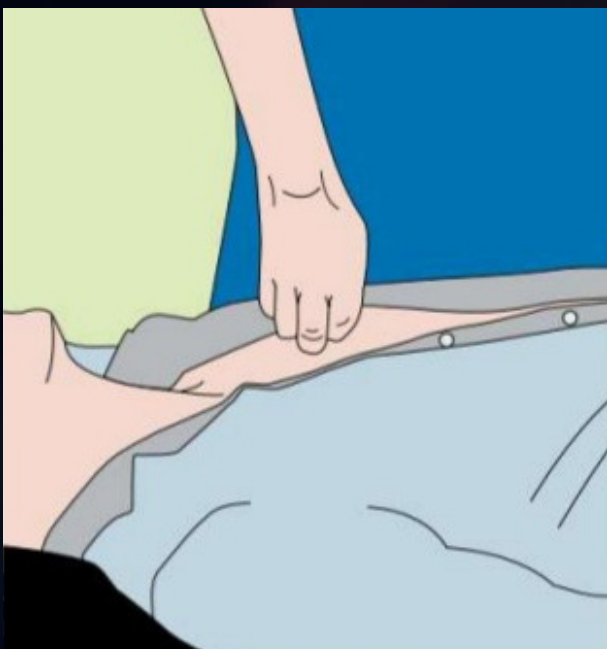
What to do during an opioid overdose?



1

S- Stimulate

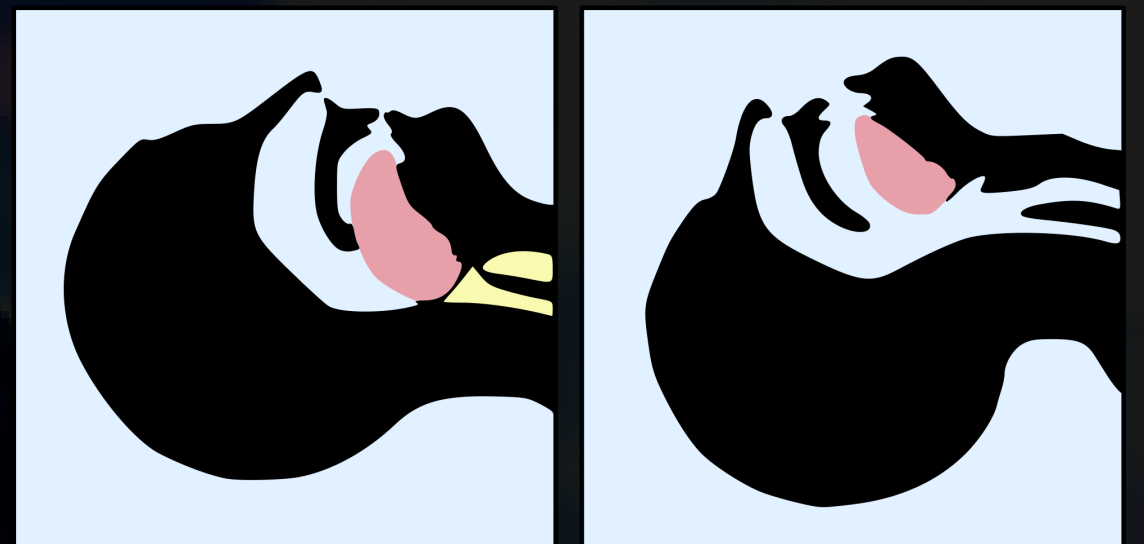
If someone is passed out, start by tapping their leg! If they do not wake up try rubbing their sternum. If there is no response call 911.



A- Airway

Check nose, and mouth for breath! See if there are any obstructions getting in the way. The head-tilt/chin-lift is the most reliable method of opening the airway.

V - Ventilate



Provide 2 rescue breaths!
Pinch the nose!
Place lips over mouth!
Blow until chest rises.
Allow chest to fall.
Repeat.

E-Evaluate

Evaluate how they are doing!
Try to see if you can find information on what substance they took, how much of it, and how long ago!

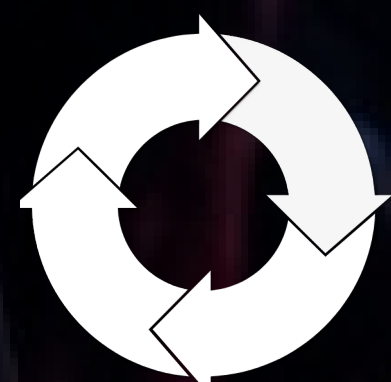
M-Medicate



Administer Naloxone.
